- Breeches or long Pants for riding (5 or more pairs)
- Underwear
- Socks
- Sneakers
- Rain Shoes or extra pair of sneakers
- Old sneakers for swimming with the horses
- Riding helmet SEI approved
- Riding boots (paddock boots best)
- Bathrobe, slippers
- Poncho or raincoat with hood
- Bathing suit
- Sandals or Teva's
- Laundry bag
- Toothbrush, toothpaste*
- Soap, Shampoo*
- Water Bottle*
- Flashlight, extra batteries*
- Writing material*
- Self sticking Stamps*
- Insect Repellent*
- Sun Screen
- Watch
- White T- Shirt for tie-dyeing*
- Comb or brush

Please try not to bring things which are harmful to the environment e.g. aerosols, disposable flashlight, etc.

Optional equipment: books, musical instruments, chaps, inexpensive camera, battery powered lantern.

Protective vest (recommended for x-country riding)

Please limit baggage to camp trunk and one duffel bag or other bag.

Please label ALL equipment and clothes with camper's name.

Camper's can send out laundry at \$4.00 per 8lb. load

Sleeveless shirts are not allowed for riding

Long pants or chaps, riding boots, and SEI approved helmet are required wear for all riding activities

Raincoat required when riding in rain

Sneakers required for swimming with the horses

Insect repellent and sunscreen are also required for camp

Items *Not* Allowed: Lighters, Candles (anything fire related), weapons, **cell phones**, and any form of drug
(prescription and over the counter drugs are to be given to the nurse only)
